

Joyride Coffee brings coffee delivery to SF

SAN FRANCISCO -- New York City coffee service Joyride Coffee has expanded to San Francisco.

The coffee company delivers specialty coffee and equipment to businesses, bringing employees their caffeine fixes right at their desks. Joyride sells craft coffee brands such as Stumptown, Joe, Intelligentsia and Blue Bottle, and also brews and sells 5-gallon kegs of iced coffee.

Joyride has opened a San Francisco office and storage facility to serve local businesses, with its eye on pouring coffee for startups and tech companies. In New York, Joyride served employees at companies such as Twitter and Rent the Runway.

Joyride Coffee was founded in 2011 by three brothers -- David, Adam and Noah Belanich -- in the back of a food truck.
